Dr. Ma Carmen Antolín is a PhD in Biological Sciences from 1991 and Professor of Plant Physiology since 1992. Since 2008 she has been a Full Professor. She is a researcher member of the Associated Unit of the CSIC (Superior Council for Scientific Research of Spain) formed among the Department of Plant Biology (Plant Biology Section) from the University of Navarra, the Experimental Station of Aula Dei (Zaragoza) and the

Institute of Sciences of the Vine and Wine (ICVV) (Logroño). Her research has been focused mainly on grapevine physiology, plant responses to abiotic and biotic stresses, organic waste management and agricultural application of sewage sludge. From her research work, they have derived more than 48 publications in scientific journals indexed with an index of relative quality (74% Q1) and 10 book chapters. She has participated in 75 conferences both nationally and internationally as well as 23 research projects. She has also directed 10 doctoral theses. At present, she has recognized 3 sexennial periods of research by the National Commission for the Evaluation of Research Activity (CNEAI). She is a reviewer in numerous scientific journals and evaluates ANEP for national projects. She currently participates in one project funded research by an autonomic organization. As a lecturer at the University of Navarra, she teaches Plant Physiology and Plant Ecophysiology to students of the Biology degree. She also participates in the teaching of the Official Master's Degree in 'Biodiversity, Landscapes and Sustainable Management'. Moreover, she is assistant director of the Department of Environmental Biology (University of Navarra) and director of the PhD Program in Biology and Environment.
